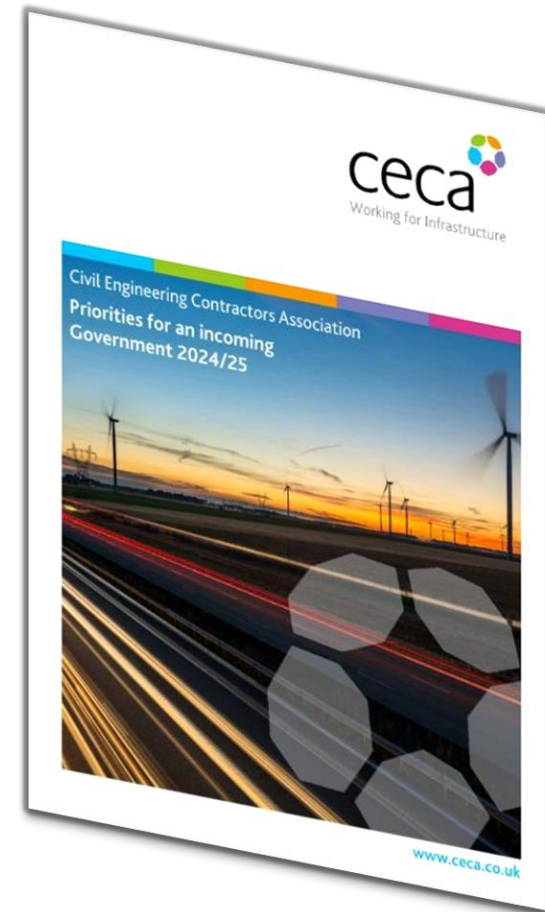

 - ▶ New 'Star Chamber' for infrastructure
- ▶ New priorities:
 - ▶ Local authority funding
 - ▶ Frameworks review
 - ▶ Standardised pipelines



Skills & Training

- ▶ Infrastructure Sector Plan under development
- ▶ Funding increased from £2 million to £2.8 million
- ▶ Themes:
 - ▶ Pipeline research (skills demand)

- ▶ CITB Consensus – early 2025

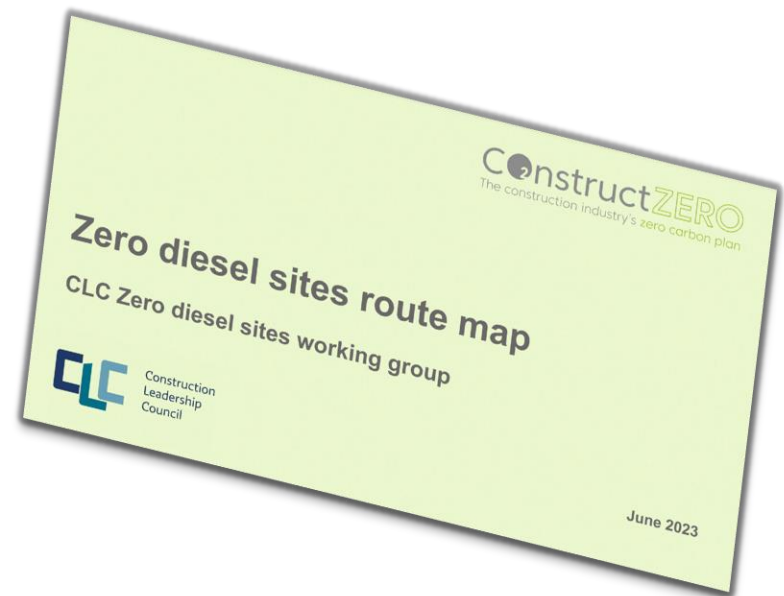


- ▶ Transferring ownership of CLC Culture of Workplace group to new chair
